Thank you for your generous response to this year's stewardship campaign. So far we have received 94 pledges totaling \$297,560.00. While some families have had to cut back their giving due to economic or other conditions and some other families have relocated (and this is having a real impact on our 2010 budget), the 94 pledges received represent an increase of \$27,846 from the giving by the same families in 2009.

We still hope and expect to receive pledges from a few remaining families before Session finalizes the 2010 budget.
